
## Martin Luther King Jr. Library Renovation Feasibility Study

### Major Goals


- Transform current building into a welcoming and light-filled space

- Upgrade infrastructure, building systems, and exterior skin








Proposed Exterior



## Street Entry

 Activate sidewalk along entry through a retail/cafe program with outdoor tables + chairs to engage pedestrians








## **Ground Floor**

- Improve way finding through clearly identified elevator cores and open stairs leading up to main reading room and auditorium below
- Utilize lobby space for events
- Create planted garden along alley wall












### 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor (Main Reading Room)

- Daylight interior with atrium
- Establish sightlines across library and visual connections between floors
- Update material palette to enhance atmosphere








# 3rd Floor (Book Stacks)

• Improve access to circulation through open stairs connecting floors 2-5








# 4<sup>th</sup> Floor (Office)

 Establish spatial connection between office space and book stacks








#### New 5<sup>th</sup> Floor


- Move displaced areas from atrium to a new 5<sup>th</sup> floor
- Potential for additional program, including conference rooms, meeting spaces, and lounge areas for staff
- Establish access to roof terrace
- Provide operable windows for offices to foster a healthy work environment
