3	TITLE IX. COUNCIL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS
4	Sec. 9011. Short title.
5	This subtitle may be cited as the "Council Reporting Requirements Act of 2013".
6	Sec. 9012. For purposes of this subtitle, unless otherwise provided, reports made to the
7	Council shall be made to the Secretary to the Council.
8	PUBLIC EDUCATION
9	Sec. 9013. District of Columbia Public Schools reporting requirements.
10	By October 1, 2013, the District of Columbia Public Schools shall:
11	(1) Submit to the Council recommendations for improving transparency of the
12	DCPS budget, including an implementation plan for establishing a single budgeting system for
13	the agency, and
14	(2) Submit to the Council and make publically available on its website, the final
15	budgets for each school along with a list of actual staff positions filled for 2013-2014 school
16	year.
17	(3) Submit a report to the Council on its work with the Department of General
18	Services to analyze DCPS energy usage and develop a mechanism that allows the agency to
19	reinvest its savings from consolidations and fixed costs into its operational needs.
20	Sec. 9014. District of Columbia Public Library requirements.
21	By October 1, 2013, the District of Columbia Public Library shall report on the planning
22	for the renovation of the Martin Luther King Jr. Central Library. The report shall include at a
23	minimum:
24	(1) A detailed update on design plans;
25	(2) A description of the project's financing including any and all public-private
26	partnerships or use of financing other than District capital funds;

1	(3) A detailed timeline on the steps that will be taken leading up to the start of
2	construction in FY17 and through to completion in FY18; and
3	(4) A description of the project's community and stakeholder engagement plan
4	with an explanation of how the project will reflect the needs and perspectives of District
5	residents.
6	Sec. 9015. Office of the State Superintendent of Education reporting requirements.
7	(a) By October 1, 2013, the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) shall
8	submit to the Council the following:
9	(1) A report on efforts to implement state-level standards addressing special
10	education transportation services, and the agency's efforts to ensure alignment of services with
11	student needs and reduce unnecessary and duplicative costs. The report shall include at a
12	minimum:
13	(A) A schedule and plan for training all LEAs and relevant IEP Team
14	participants on the new standards;
15	(B) An update on the agency's work to determine fidelity to the
16	established standards, including criteria for eligibility; and
17	(C) Recommendations for how the District could enhance transportation
18	services and reduce costs, including contracting with outside vendors to provide transportation at
19	a reduced cost for students attending non-public schools outside of the District of Columbia,
20	shared routes and staggered school start times.
21	(2) A report on the status of implementing the Partnership for Assessment of
22	Readiness of College and Careers (PARCC) Assessment in public schools. The report shall
23	include at a minimum:
24	(A) Barriers to implementation;
25	(B) Program and technological enhancements needed to administer the
26	new assessment; and
